The proposed registered voter totals will be as follows utilizing the new boundaries:

District 10 - currently 941 voters - proposal 1479 voters
District 12 - currently 1708 voters - proposal 1512 voters
District 13 - currently 2308 voters - proposal 1724 voters
District 14 - currently 1158 voters - proposal 1400 voters

Ms. Sikes reported the proposed changes comply with the Charter, are a fair representation of the registered voters and comply with the requirements of the Federal Voting Right Act.
