**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article V, Section 512 of the Charter of the City of Lake City, Florida, the City Council, acting in its capacity as the Canvassing Board for said election, at a special meeting on Wednesday, August 27, 2014, at Noon, determined and found that the result from the canvass of the returns that RICKY JERNIGAN, received 112 votes, and GEORGE WARD received 264 votes; and

**WHEREAS**, as the winner of a majority of the votes GEORGE WARD is entitled to be declared to be the duly elected City Councilmember for District 14 of the City in the August 26, 2014, primary election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of the City Charter, City ordinances and other applicable provisions of the general election laws of the State of Florida, GEORGE WARD is hereby declared to be the duly elected City Councilmember for District 14 of the City for a term of four (4) years, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 509(c) shall assume office at the first regularly scheduled City Council Meeting

following the immediate preceding 2014 November State General Election, upon taking and subscribing an oath or affirmation required by Section 513 of the City Charter.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions and requirements of the City Charter and all applicable general laws of the State of Florida, ADEE FARMER, EUGENE JEFFERSON, and HAROLD PERRY, properly qualified for the seat of City Councilmember for District 10 of the City in the August 26, 2014, primary election; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article V, Section 512 of the Charter of the City of Lake City, Florida, the City Council, acting in its capacity as the Canvassing Board for said election, at a special meeting on Wednesday, August 27, 2014, at Noon, determined and found that the result from the canvass of the returns that ADEE FARMER, received 117 votes, EUGENE JEFFERSON, received 299 votes, and HAROLD PERRY, received 58 votes; and

**WHEREAS**, as the winner of a majority of the votes EUGENE JEFFERSON is entitled to be declared to be the duly elected City Councilmember for District 10 of the City in the August 26, 2014, primary election.

Section 509(c) shall assume office at the first regularly scheduled City Council Meeting following the immediate preceding 2014 November State General Election, upon taking and subscribing an oath or affirmation required by Section 513 of the City Charter.
