Mr. Henry stated the total cost would be \$63,000. If the City received the grant then City would contribute \$13,000.


Mr. Helfenberger stated he and Mr. Henry would rework the plans to accommodate the concern of the location of the Tennis Courts to the Pickleball Courts.
