All bid proposals which are submitted through delivery services such as Federal Express, UPS, or United States Postal Service Express Mail, must be marked on the OUTSIDE of the delivery package with the company or Bidder's name, address, phone number, bid number (ITB-007-2017), bid title (WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT INFLUENT BUILDING DOORWAY REPAIR) the date and time (Tuesday, March 21, 2017 at 11:00 a.m.). The bid proposal must be in a sealed envelope INSIDE the delivery package with the same information as listed above. All bid proposals which are hand delivered or delivered through regular mail by the United States Postal Service must have all the same information as listed above on the OUTSIDE of the sealed envelope. Failure to comply may be reason to reject the bid.

One original plus one copy must be included and must be addressed to the following:

City of Lake City Attn: Procurement Department 205 N Marion Avenue Lake City, Florida 32055 Bids must be completed in English language, signed with ink, in spaces provided on the enclosed bid forms and submitted in duplicate or bid will be subject to rejection.

Any deviation from the specifications must be explained in detail on sheets attached to the bid form and labeled "Clarifications and Exceptions," and each deviation must be itemized by number and must specifically refer to the applicable specification paragraph and page. Otherwise it will be considered that items offered are in strict compliance with these specifications and the successful Bidder will be held responsible for meeting the specification. All questions must be in writing and directed to the Procurement Director. All questions will be answered in writing. Any answers which may alter the scope of work will be answered in the form of addenda. Any and all addenda must be signed and returned with the original response to be considered responsive. Deadline for receiving questions is **Monday, March 13, 2017 at 4:00 p.m**. Questions received after this date and time will not be considered. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to procurement@lcfla.com or by mail to City of Lake City, Procurement Department, 205 N. Marion Avenue, Lake City, FL 32055.

The City of Lake City is exempt from State Use Tax, State Retail Tax and Federal Excise Tax. The bid price must be net, exclusive of taxes. Bidder's proposal must be dated, signed by authorized representative, title, firm name, address, and telephone number.

Local Vendor Preference: City of Lake City Administrative Policy #18 states that the bid of a resident of Columbia County, Florida will have a 5% preference over the bid submitted by any non-resident of Columbia County. A resident is defined as an individual whose primary residence is within Columbia County, Florida, a partnership whose principals are all residents of Columbia County, Florida, partnership or other business entity whose principal place of business is within Columbia County, Florida, or which maintains a full time business office open to the public within Columbia County, Florida. With these and other contributing factors the City Council reserves the right to award a bid or contract in the best interest of the City.

Respondents to this solicitation or persons acting on their behalf may not contact, between the release of the solicitation and the end of the (seventy two) 72-hour period following the agency posting the notice of intended award, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and city holidays, any employee or officer of the executive or legislative branch concerning any aspect of this solicitation, except in writing to the Procurement Department or as provided in the solicitation documents. Violation of this provision may be grounds for rejecting a response.

Any Bidder desirous of protesting a bid for any reason must file a written notice of bid protest with the City Manager's office within seventy two (72) hours following posting of notice of intended award. All protest will be in writing stating the bid being protested and the specific reason of the protest. All protest will be signed by the Protestor and include all detail for a complete and thorough review. The decision of the City Manager, after consultation with the City Attorney will be issued within five (5) working days of the receipt of the protest, unless additional time is agreed upon by all parties involved should circumstance warrant such a delay.

By submission of his/her bid, the Bidder certifies that:

- A. The bid has been arrived at by the Bidder independently and has been submitted without collusion with any other vendor of materials, supplies, or equipment described in the Invitation to Bid.
- B. The contents of the bid have not been communicated by the Bidder, his/her employees or agents, to his/her best knowledge and belief, to any person not an employee or agent of the Bidder or his surety in any bond furnished herewith and will not be communicated to any such person prior to the official opening of the bids.

The City of Lake City reserves the right to accept or reject any/all bids and to award the contract in the best interest of the City of Lake City, Florida.

SEALED BIDS ARE BEING ACCEPTED BY THE CITY OF LAKE CITY FROM QUALIFIED BIDDERS/CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE ALL PARTS, LABOR, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT NECESSARY TO PERFORM THE SCOPE OF WORK HEREIN.

#### "SCOPE OF WORK"

- 1. Supply all labor, materials and equipment to replace existing double doors and frames on east and west side of building.
- 2. Remove existing precast lintels and windows on east and west side of building.
- 3. Infill existing windows with CMU (Concrete Masonry Unit).
- 4. Contractor must place supports under the existing concrete beams for demolition purposes.
- 5. Install 16 gauge 534 4FH A60 galvanized welded steel hollow metal door frames for masonry application.
- 6. Install 24" wide louvered 18 gauge metal 1 3/4" thickness, hollow stainless steel double doors. Doors should be louvered at the bottom. Louvers must be screened to prevent insects and or birds from entering the building. Door face sheets and frames profiles must be fabricated from Type 304 stainless steel, conforming to ASTM A 666. Interior components for exterior applications are manufactured from A60 (ZF180) zinc-coated steel conforming to ASTM A 653/A 653M, CS, Type B.
- 7. Commercial finish hardware to include:
  - Continuous Gear Hinges
  - Grade 1 Cylindrical locks appropriate for the door application.
    - o latch bolt must operate by lever from either side or key in outside lever
    - o outside lever must lock by push button on inside
    - outside lever must unlock by key from outside, or by rotating the inside lever.
  - Grade 1 Commercial heavy duty door closers on each door with the option to hold open the door
  - Thresholds
  - Sweeps
  - Seals
  - Rain Drips
  - Flush bolts
  - 2 Keys for each door.
- 8. Pour cell fills at door jamb from floor to structure above, and lintels above door.

- 9. Paint double doors and CMU corner to corner. Paint doors, frames and walls to match the current colors.
- 10. All work is to comply with current building codes. All pertinent permits must be obtained by the contractor if needed. Existing equipment on walls must be reattached to new walls.

# C. CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY:

- 1. Project site must be maintained in a clean and safe environment at all times this contract is in effect.
- 2. Contractor must comply with all State, Federal and local safety regulations as pertains to work awarded by contract from this bid.

#### D. LICENSE/PERMITS:

- 1. All Contractor's together with any Sub-Contractor's must be qualified and licensed under the laws, rules and regulations of the State of Florida and the City of Lake City, Florida to perform the work required by these contract documents. Contractor's qualifications including equipment to be used for this project will be subject to review and approval by the City prior to award. Contractor must be prepared to demonstrate, through previous experience and references, the ability to safely and successfully perform this size and type of project.
- 2. The awarded bidder shall secure permits and arrange for inspections as required.

3. If after the awarded Contractor has completed the work and it is found upon inspection not to be satisfactorily completed, the Contractor will have a specified time to correctly complete the work. Upon completion the Contractor will request a final inspection of all work. If the Contractor fails or refuses to complete the work to the City's satisfaction, the City reserves the right to procure the services from another source and hold the Contractor responsible for any costs associated or incurred.

# E. INSURANCE:

- 1. Without limiting Bidders indemnification, it is agreed that the successful Bidder will purchase at their expense and maintain in force at all times during the performance of services under this agreement the following insurance. Where specific limits are shown, it is understood that they must be the minimum acceptable limits. If successful Bidders policy contains higher limits, the City of Lake City will be entitled to coverage to the extent of such higher limits. Certificates of Insurance must be furnished to the City naming the City of Lake City as additional insured. These certificates must provide a ten (10) calendar day notice to the City in the event of cancellation, non-renewal or a material change in the policy. The City of Lake City must be exempt from, and in no way liable for, any sums of money which may represent a deductible in any insurance policy. The payment of such deductible must be the sole responsibility of the vendor/contractor and/or subcontractor providing such insurance. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing insurance of all sub-contractors to the City of Lake City Procurement Department prior to performance of any work on this project.
  - a. Statutory Workers Compensation insurance as required by the State of Florida.
  - b. Commercial General Liability insurance to provide coverage of claims to a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence for property damage and bodily injury including coverage for premise operations, products completed operations and personal injury.
  - c. Business Vehicle/Umbrella Liability insurance with a minimum limit of \$100,000 per occurrence for property damage and personal injury. Coverage must be stipulated for owned/leased vehicles, non-owned vehicles, and hired vehicles.
- 2. Prior to commencement of work, the Bidder will submit certificates of insurance to the City of Lake City naming the City of Lake City as additional insured, indicating the Bidder coverage's in the limits as specified, and stating that the City of Lake City will be provided a ten (10) day notice prior to cancellation of any of the policies.

# F. INDEMNITY:

Successful Contractor will indemnify and hold the City of Lake City and City's agents harmless from any loss, cost, damage or injury sustained by any persons (s) as a result of the actions of employees or officers of the Contractor, Sub-Contractors or suppliers.

# G. <u>LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:</u>

In the event the Bidder is awarded the contract and fails to complete the work within the time limit or extended time limit agreed upon, liquated damages will be paid to the City of Lake City at an amount not to exceed actual damages incurred by the City per day.

# H. <u>SPECIAL CONDITIONS:</u>

- 1. Time limit for completion of work shall be thirty (30) calendar days from Notice to Proceed issued by the City of Lake City. Requests for extension, if allowed, shall be approved by the City Manager.
- 2. Extended time may be allowed for the completion of this project due to inclement weather. Any and all extensions must be approved by the City Manager prior to allowing the change.
- 3. Decisions to allow days added to the contract due to inclement weather will be based upon weather records as recorded with the State of Florida, Division of Forestry located in Lake City, Florida and approved by the City Manager.
- 4. In the event additional days are requested and awarded, the contractor must notify the City of Lake City Procurement department at the beginning of work stoppage and each succeeding day until work can be safely resumed.
- 5. All trash, debris and/or construction material must be properly disposed of in accordance with the City of Lake City and/or Columbia County ordinances.

#### I. CONTRACT:

The successful Contractor will execute the contract within ten (10) calendar days after Notice of Award. Upon receipt of all required documents, a Notice to Proceed will be issued.

#### J. SCHEDULE:

The successful Contractor must complete all work within 30 calendar days of Notice to Proceed.

# K. SUBMITTALS:

- 1. The following list of documents must be submitted to the City of Lake City prior to payment.
  - a. Manufacturer's warranty on all installed materials and equipment.
  - b. Written warranty by contractor providing one (1) year warranty on labor, workmanship and materials.

# L. PAYMENT:

Payment will be based on: (a) City's acceptance of work, and (b) submitted evidence, if requested by the City, that all payrolls, materials, bills, and indebtedness connected with the work have been paid. The City may withhold an amount as may be necessary to pay such claims for labor and services rendered and materials involved with the work. It is the expectation of the City that one invoice will be submitted by the Contractor upon completion of the project. Payment to the Contractor will be made in accordance with FS 218.70 "Local Government Prompt Payment Act" upon receipt of invoice, assuming there are no contested amounts with the invoice.

# M. EXPERIENCE AND REFERENCES:

Bidders must provide on the form provided and with their proposal substantial material for evaluating the ability of the potential Bidder to execute a project of this type. Therefore, the Bidder is required to provide a minimum of (3) three references, which will be verified. The list of references must be attached with the bid proposal on the form provided within these specifications. All reference materials provided become the property of the City of Lake City and also become public record.

# N. ADDENDUM:

It will be the sole responsibility of the bidder to contact the Procurement Department prior to submitting a bid to determine if any addenda have been issued, to obtain such addenda, and to acknowledge addenda with their bid.

#### O. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

The enclosed documents must be executed and returned with bid proposal or the proposal may be considered non-responsive. (Conflict of Interest Statement, Disputes Disclosure Form, Drug Free Workplace Certificate, Non-Collusion Affidavit of Proposer, Reference, Public Entity Crime Statement and E-verify Affirmation Statement.)

#### P. EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION (E-VERIFY):

In accordance with State of Florida, Office of the Governor, Executive Order 11-116 (superseding Executive Order 11-02; Verification of Employment Status), in the event performance of this Agreement is or will be funded using state or federal funds, the CONTRACTOR must comply with the Employment Eligibility Verification Program ("E-Verify Program") developed by the federal government to verify the eligibility of individuals to work in the United States and 48 CFR 52.222-54 (as amended) is incorporated herein by reference. If applicable, in accordance with Subpart 22.18 of the Federal Acquisition Register, the CONTRACTOR must (1) enroll in the E-Verify Program, (2) use E-Verify to verify the employment eligibility of all new hires working in the United States, except if the CONTRACTOR is a state or local government, the CONTRACTOR may choose to verify only new hires assigned to the Agreement; (3) use E-Verify to verify the employment eligibility of all employees assigned to the Agreement; and (4) include these

# Q. PUBLIC RECORD:

The Owner is a public agency subject to Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. The Contractor shall comply with Florida's public records law. Specifically, the Contractor shall:

- 1. Keep and maintain public records required by the public agency to perform the service.
- 2. Upon request from the public agency's custodian of public records, provide the public agency with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in this chapter or as otherwise provided by law.
- 3. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the contract term and following completion of the contract if the contractor does not transfer the records to the public agency.
- 4. Upon completion of the contract, transfer, at no cost, to the public agency all public records in possession of the contractor or keep and maintain public records required by the public agency to perform the service. If the contractor transfers all public records to the public agency upon completion of the contract, the contractor shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the contractor keeps and maintains public records upon completion of the contract, the contractor shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the public agency, upon request from the public agency's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the public agency.

3. All changes or additions will be approved by the City of Lake City prior to work being initiated.

# S. <u>WARRANTY:</u>

Provide a one (1) year warranty with an anniversary inspection at eleven (11) months after the completion of the project to identify and repair any defects. Defects shall be repaired at no cost to the City of Lake City.

# T. <u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:</u>

The City of Lake City Procurement Department reserves the right to request any additional information needed for clarification from any Bidder for evaluation purposes.
