Page 3 of 19 – Scope of Service

(C) Current Billing Options

The City is responsible for all residential billing. Can the City provide the number of residential units billed and the amount of revenue billed for the most current month?

The month of May 2012 we billed 3,355 residential customers \$38,501.93. We estimate 4000 customers a month to account for growth.

Page 6 of 19 – Scope of Service (Technical)

(V) The City currently utilizes sixteen (16) dumpsters, four 2 yards, five 4 yards two 6 yards and five 8 yards with various pick-up schedules.

What are the locations with address, number of containers, container size and frequency of service? **This information is not available at this time.**

Attachment B Price Form

1. Please explain the type of service you are asking under manual? We assume there are no carts provided under this option and contractor would pick up bags and customer owned garbage cans. **Carts need to be provided, manual would mean someone physically handling cart and dispensing into truck.**
2. Frontload Container (Dumpsters) price sheet has no mechanism for pricing on size or frequency (weekly, monthly). **Example: 8 yard container serviced 2 times per week x 4.33 (52weeks a year divided by 12) x price per cubic yard = price per month.**
3. Are commercial 96 gallon carts to be serviced 1 time per week? **They are to be serviced per customer needs, if additional pickups are needed they will be charged for additional pick ups.**
4. Under the Special Waste Pricing Option, would the City consider a price to pick-up items on an on call basis instead of one time per week? This option would be more cost effective for the City instead of the contractor pricing service of 1 time per week. **Special waste should be priced on an as needed basis.**
5. Is Container rental based on a weekly or monthly rate for 20 yard, 30 yard and 40 yard containers? **Monthly rate.**
6. Can the Contractor provide alternative pricing with a yearly CPI or Fuel Adjustment increase? **Price is adjusted by CPI only after the initial 5 years.**

Other Questions

Location and Contact Person with the City where we may pick up schedules and routes.

The only schedule and routes available were provided.

Are the Insurance requirements on Page 44 , 45 & 46 of the existing Republic and City of Lake City Contract going to remain the same under the new agreement? **Yes, requirements will remain the same.**

Are the Adjustments of Rate charges for changes in Landfill Disposal Rates (page 60 & 61) of the Republic and City of Lake City Contract going to be the same under the new agreement? **Will be negotiated.**
