Series of Burglaries - One Arrested

On Friday, August 9, 2024, at approximately 2:30 a.m., officers responded to SW Tularosa Lane regarding a vehicle burglary in progress. The caller provided a description of the suspect: a white male wearing a blue long-sleeve shirt and a hat.

Upon arrival, officers searched the area and discovered additional vehicles had been burglarized. An abandoned ATV was also found along the wood line of the neighborhood. The ATV was still warm from recent use, and a wallet containing the driver's license of Johnathan Eversole was located in the front compartment.

After reviewing surveillance footage provided by a victim, officers positively identified Johnathan Eversole as the suspect. Eversole was arrested and charged with burglary.

Two additional suspects have been identified.
