Handgun fired during altercation leads to arrest

On Thursday, August 1, 2024 at 11:08 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department responded to a report of a disturbance involving a firearm at NW Bascom Norris Drive, Cedar Park Apartments. While on their way, officers were given a description of a Black female who witnesses saw firing a handgun in the courtyard of the apartment complex.

Upon arrival, officers located a Black female who matched the suspect's description. After detaining her, officers did a pat-down for safety. During the pat-down of Jennifer Diane Huff, born on 09/25/1985, they found a firearm. A records check showed that Huff was a convicted felon and could not legally have a firearm.

Further investigation and review of the complex's video surveillance showed Huff firing the firearm twice after a verbal argument. Huff was arrested and taken to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.
