Three arrested after robbery

On Wednesday, November 6, 2024 at 8:15 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department responded to Cedar Park Apartments, located at 443 NW Bascom Norris Drive to the report of a robbery.

Columbia County Combined Communications Officers provided responding officers with a vehicle description being occupied by the suspects involved in the robbery.

Upon arriving in the area, officers observed the described vehicle and attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a gold Chevrolet passenger vehicle bearing a Georgia license plate. The driver of the gold vehicle failed to stop and a brief pursuit ensued.

The driver stopped the vehicle at the intersection of NW Main Blvd and NW Bascom Norris Drive where three occupants of the vehicle were taken into custody without further incident.

Jayveon Montroll Hall, Jay'lyn Reginald La'Var Kates and Kenyon Drashon Denson were arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.

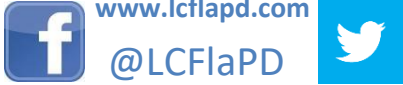
