On Thursday, December 5, 2024 at 8:00 P.M., an officer from the Lake City Police Department who was working an off duty detail at 2767 W US Hwy 90, Walmart, were alerted to the theft of a wallet which had just occurred.

The officer reviewed in-store surveillance footage and observed the suspect taking the wallet. A description of the suspect was promptly shared with all on-duty officers. Shortly afterward, it was reported that a credit card from the stolen wallet had been used in an attempt at another nearby merchant.

Officers responded to the area and were able to locate Lacey Mae Wilson, who was still in possession of the stolen items. During the investigation, officers discovered that both Wilson and Randall Gerald Ratliff, who was accompanying Wilson, had outstanding warrants for their arrest.

Wilson and Ratliff were taken into custody and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.

"I would like to take this opportunity to remind our citizens to be vigilant with their personal belongings and items they have purchased while shopping during the holiday season." Stated Chief of Police Gerald Butler "Not everyone is as honest as we'd hope, and unfortunately, the holiday season can bring an increase in thefts and opportunistic crimes. By staying aware of your surroundings and taking precautions, you can significantly reduce the risk of becoming a victim."
