Two arrested loitering near hospital

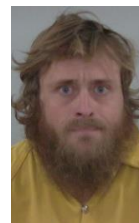
On Thursday, January 2, 2025, at 8:11 P.M., an officer from the Lake City Police Department, who was working an off-duty detail at HCA Lake City Hospital, was notified by an employee about two individuals looking into vehicles parked in the hospital parking lot.

The officer observed one individual, Ian Joseph Neunz, attempting to conceal himself near some trees. Neunz was unable to explain why he was in the hospital parking lot or why he was looking into vehicle windows.

A second individual, Jordan Anthony Smith, was seen riding a bicycle in the parking lot. When the officer attempted to speak with Smith, he dropped his bicycle and fled on foot behind a hospital building. After a brief chase, Smith was located and found to be in possession of drugs and drug paraphernalia. Additionally, he had two outstanding warrants for his arrest.

It is not believed that any vehicles were broken into, as officers were able to locate the suspects before any burglaries were committed.
